GRANT GUIDELINES

The Purpose of the FNHCB

Established in 1989 as a 501 (c)(3) organization, The Foundation of the New Haven County Bar is a philanthropic organization that provides a means for the organized Bar to support the New Haven County community.

Grant making Priorities

Applications will be accepted for projects and/or activities that will achieve one or more of the following:

- a. To maintain the honor and dignity of the profession of the law;
- b. To promote legal science and the administration of justice;
- c. To promote the efficiency and integrity of the judicial process;
- d. To establish and/or provide for organized entities or facilities for the furnishing of legal services to all citizens;
- e. To apply knowledge and experience in the field of law to the promotion of the public good; and
- f. To support charitable programs that assists the needy.

Priority consideration will be given to: 1) projects and/or activities supported by a committee(s) of the New Haven County Bar Association; and 2) special projects and/or activities of New Haven County organizations and bar associations that meet FNHCB grant-making priorities.

Limitations

Grants will NOT be made:

- a. in support of religious, political or lobbying purposes;
- b. to individuals with the exception of scholarships and/or prizes; or
- c. as loans.

Application Procedure

There are two funding cycles annually with decisions generally made in November and May. Applications are due October 15th and April 15th. The Foundation distributes one or more grants a year up to \$10,000 in sum.

Application Review and Notification

The FNHCB will acknowledge in writing the receipt of each grant application. The Grant Making Committee will review all applications. Based upon this review, a recommendation regarding funding will be made to the FNHCB Board of Directors. The Board approves all grant awards, and notification of awards will be made in writing. A brief evaluation report will be required upon completion of the project.
